Volunteer Title: Event Photographer

Purpose: The Event Photographer serves as the individual responsible for capturing a photographic record of programming events held by the Pipestone County Historical Society.

Location: The Event Photographer will take pictures at programming events schedule both on and off site. These events will be held within Pipestone County. Many events are held within Pipestone City Limits though the photographer may be asked to assist at events anywhere throughout the county. Events may be scheduled both in- and outdoors.

Key Responsibilities:

- Takes pictures of Museum staff, guest speakers, and guests at programming events hosted by the Pipestone County Historical Society.

Reports to Museum staff with any questions or concerns.

The Length of Appointment: The Events Photographer is available in an on-call manner as events are scheduled by the Pipestone County Museum.

Time Commitment: Anywhere from 2 to up to 4 hours per event. Events are generally scheduled during regular business hours (Tuesday-Saturday 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.) though some events may be held outside of these hours.

Qualifications: Working knowledge of basic photography. Understands basic lighting and angles to capture the most visually appealing images possible. Has the ability to stand for a length of time, climb stairs and walk on uneven ground when events are held outside.

Support: Expectations of each event will be outlined by Museum staff prior to the day of the event.
